**May Meeting Demonstration by Lyn Belisle**



**Composition Camp: Collage into Painting**

**Lyn Belisle, Artist-in-Residence at Lyn Belisle Studio in San Antonio**

This demonstration/workshop takes a lively approach to exploring composition using the interrelationship between collage and painting. We will work with Lyn’s **AB3 System of Composition** as a springboard for ideas in mixed media work and painting.

The appeal of this “collage into painting” method is two-fold. First is its usefulness for both the representation and abstract artist. It allows a painter to envision several “right answers” to each composition while creating journal-like collage studies. Secondly, these studies can be done with almost any materials at hand without the cost of specialized media. And it’s risk-free, relaxed fun!

Lyn Belisle is a lifelong artist, educator and author who has worked in an eclectic range of mixed-media arts and graphic design throughout her career. She offers numerous popular mixed-media workshops at Lyn Belisle Studio in San Antonio which she founded in January of 2013. Her favorite materials are earthenware, paper and fiber, and she recently began a new series of PhotoEncaustic collages, which have won Best in Show for the past two years at Blue Star’s Artists Who Teach exhibit. She has authored two articles for Cloth Paper Scissors magazine, an ebook on PhotoEncaustic collage, and a coloring book on the folk art of Mexico. Her seven workshop DVDs are available from Artful Gathering. Lyn has had six one-person gallery exhibits since 2011 and has been included in numerous group shows and invitationals. She is represented by La Vida Gallery in San Antonio and Dan Pfeiffer Gallery in Fredericksburg, Texas.
