January Meeting Demo Susie Monday

The Grammar and Alphabet of Creative Work

Susie will do a short slide lecture on creative process and the missing alphabet, followed by some creative activities with the audience. She will also provide time for Q&A.

Each of us comes into the world with creative strengths, and our families and life experiences add (and detract) from our unique way of looking at, processing and reinventing the world in our lives and in our art. Think of your senses as paying attention to the alphabet of creativity, and the way you put information together to make art as the grammar of your work. In this demo we'll explore creative strong suits through the vocabulary of the senses (line, shape, movement, rhythm, space, shape, texture, color and sound) an look at your personal grammar of your mind at work. We'll be drawing, collaging and making a joyful noise as we work and play together, sharing our differences and our similarities as artists in diverse media.



Bio of Susie Monday

Susie Monday is an artist and teacher who works from her studio in Pipe Creek. Her large textile collage stitched art evokes the culture, stories and landscapes of the Texas Borderlands — the inner creative life of the artist. Working in mixed media on fabric, Susie dyes, screen prints and/or digitally designs much of the fabrics she uses. She has work in the current Fiber Artists of San Antonio exhibit at SAY Si, 1518 South Alamo in San Antonio. One of her pieces is an award-winning piece! The Exhibit is will be open January 2 through January 26.

A graduate of Trinity University in San Antonio, Susie has also taught art, creative process and design process to children, teachers, artists and writers across the country, both in person and online. Over the past 40 years, she has designed exhibits and programs and served as a consultant to numerous museums, art institutions, school districts and corporations, notably the the Museum of Modern Art, The Smithsonian Institution, Children's Museum of San Antonio, the San Antonio Botanical Gardens, Campfire Girls and Boys, The San Antonio Public Library, Neiman Marcus, Dallas Museum of Fine Arts and Big Thought, Dallas. Guidelines for Rental of New Braunfels Art League's 2nd Floor Studios

Executed by the NBAL Executive Board on December 10, 2006

Revised and Executed by the NBAL Executive Board on December 12, 2016

- 1. Studios will be leased to NBAL members only. They may only be used as artist studios.
- 2. Studios will have one year leases.
- 3. Studios will be advertised for lease in the NBAL newsletter when current lease options expire or if a vacancy occurs. If more than one person requests to rent a studio, once the notice of intent to vacate is received, a lottery to select the new tenant will occur. This will occur at a general membership meeting. All requests to be considered as a potential tenant must be submitted in writing to the Executive Board. Prior to selecting a new tenant, the opportunity to lease the space must be advertised for 30 days in the newsletter.
- **4. Tenants** shall have the option to **renew their lease for a period of up to five years** beginning 2007. **Once the five year option expires,** they cannot **place** their name in the lottery for two years.
- 5. The front north/west studio currently leased to Linda Jacobson will be rented to a member who offers art classes to children on weekends **and/or** after school. This promotes NBAL's mission statement and community outreach goal. If no other member (s) request this studio for this purpose, Linda Jacobson will continue to be eligible to lease it **on a yearly basis as long as she provides classes to children as stated above.**
- 6. Anyone wishing to rent a studio to provide children's or adult's classes, (whether private lessons or in a group setting), must provide a written Business Plan of Operation for approval to the Executive Board before consideration of potential tenancy. Additionally, 2 adults must be present in the classroom at all times lessons for children are being held, whether private or in a group setting.
- 7. Anyone wishing to provide lessons or classes in their studio space must provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance to the Executive Board listing NBAL as an additional insured entity prior final execution of the lease.
- 8. The front south/west studio currently rented to the GRAG group will continue to be available to the group. Other NBAL members may share in renting this studio as long as the GRAG group opens a space to them. Rent will be due as specified in the lease agreement for this studio. All members who use this studio must pay NBAL annual dues.
- 9. Rental fees will be determined by the Executive Board on a yearly basis.
