Demo for June Meeting

Leila Reynolds

Screen printing for unique effects in art

Leila Reynolds began her art experience more than forty years ago, painting with oils and watercolors. She transitioned to painting on silk when living in England. After moving to New Braunfels she continued to work in fiber and wearable art, learning surface design techniques, such as shibori dyeing, screen printing, stamping, wax resist, and image transfer. For the last two years she has experimented in oils and acrylics, as well as cold wax and oil and encaustic painting, using some of the surface design techniques she learned as a fiber artist.

Reynolds will demonstrate the use of screen printing on a variety of surfaces to create unique designs in your art. Reynolds will use the traditional silk screen as well as a Thermofax screen to apply inks and paints on paper, canvas, board and fabric.

Thermofax machines were used many years ago to cut stencils for mimeograph printing. Today, they are being used by artists to burn images for printing on a variety of surfaces. More information about this during the demonstration!
